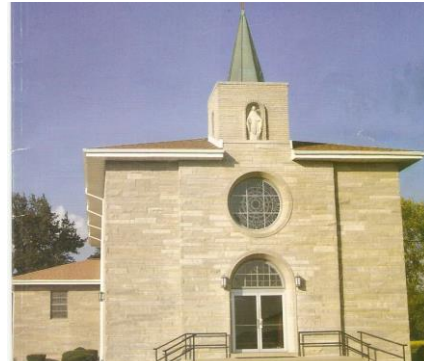

The Effingham Knight of Columbus Council 665 has launched a Fundraising Campaign to raise funds for a new ultrasound machine for the Family Life Center in Effingham. We have been accepted into the Ultrasound Initiative Program through our Supreme Council. The Ultrasound Initiative Program began in 2009 and to date has helped fund over 1,500 new machines in all 50 states, as well as in Canada, Guatemala, Jamaica, and Peru.
