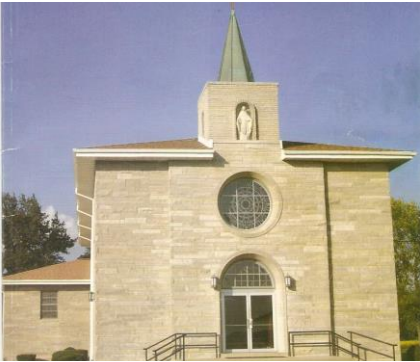

Family Connection Luke 18:9-14

In the family, one sometimes observes a level of competition between children for parent attention,
for acknowledgement of their abilities. Somehow, children seem to internalize that the attention given to
one member of the family diminishes the attention given to another. In this way, children can often sound
like the Pharisee in Jesus' parable. Parents who provide continual reminders to their children that they are
loved for who they are, not for what they do, help children develop a healthy spirituality.

As a family, talk about what it means to compare oneself to another. Discuss whether it is helpful to
compare oneself to another. In what ways might this be positive? (when it motivates one to use one's
talents) In what circumstances might this be unhelpful? (when it proves discouraging, when it prevents one
from valuing the abilities of another)

As a family, read today's Gospel, Luke 18:9-14. Discuss: What was wrong about the prayer of the
Pharisee? How can we emulate the prayer of the tax collector?

Pray together as a family in thanksgiving for the blessing that is each member of your family. Pray
that your family will be free from unhealthy competition. Pray in thanksgiving that God's love for us is
unconditional.

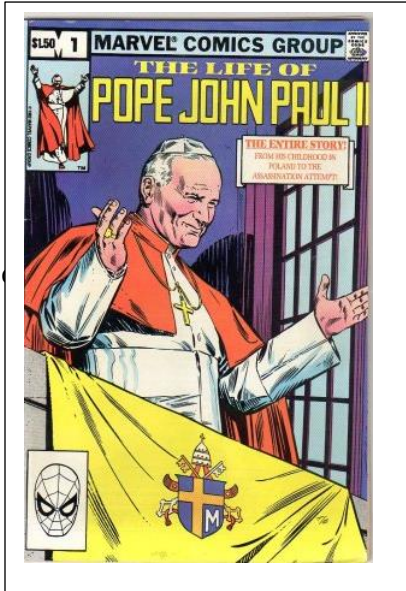

St. Pope John Paul II Feast Day- Oct. 22 "Cheat Sheet"

Although it is traditional to celebrate the Saint's feast day on the day they died, the feast day of St. Pope John Paul II is on the anniversary of his papal inauguration.

- Also known as "JP2" (said as "J P two") and sometimes referred to as St. John Paul the Great
- Birth name Karol Józef Wojtyła
- Polish
- Was the Pope from 1978 – 2005
- Instituted Divine Mercy Sunday, and was canonized on Divine Mercy Sunday in 2014
- Instituted World Youth Day
- Added 5 new mysteries to the rosary- the Luminous Mysteries!
- He spoke 12 languages
- He loved outdoor activities including hiking, kayaking, camping, and skiing. He continued skiing until he was 73 years old!
- While Pope, he visited 129 countries, traveling over a million kilometers, making him the most widely traveled person about his travels here.
- He canonized over 400 Saints including St. Padre Pio, St. Juan Diego, St. Maximilian Kolbe, and St. Bakhita
- He wrote an average of 3,000 pages a year during his papacy
- He was seen by more people than any other person ever in human history
- Marvel wrote a comic book about him



Knights of Columbus Fundraising for Ultrasound Machine

The Effingham Knight of Columbus Council 665 has launched a Fundraising Campaign to raise funds for a new ultrasound machine for the Family Life Center in Effingham. We have been accepted into the Ultrasound Initiative Program through our Supreme Council. The Ultrasound Initiative Program began in 2009 and to date has helped fund over 1,500 new machines in all 50 states, as well as in Canada, Guatemala, Jamaica, and Peru. Through this program, if a local Council raises 50% of the cost, the Supreme Council will provide a matching grant for the other 50% to complete the funding and allow for the purchase of a new ultrasound machine. This is a tremendous opportunity to equip medically certified pro-life pregnancy centers with the modern technology that will enable expectant mothers to see and hear their babies in utero and recognize the miracle of new life within them.
