



EUCHARIST REVIVAL

As we continue our journey toward a Eucharistic Revival, I read an article by Bishop Andrew Cozzens, Bishop of Crookston, Minnesota, about how the Eucharist catechizes us about the meaning of life (read the article [here https://www.eucharisticrevival.org/post/the-spiritual-life-how-the-eucharist-catechizes-about-the-meaning-of-life](https://www.eucharisticrevival.org/post/the-spiritual-life-how-the-eucharist-catechizes-about-the-meaning-of-life).) In the article Bishop Cozzens reminds us that the Eucharist, as source and summit of our faith, is essential to catechesis. Everything we do as a Church should bring us to the Eucharist where we encounter Christ truly present in the bread and wine. As Bishop Cozzens states, "The Eucharist is not only a place to encounter Jesus and receive his life, the source, but also the place where we give him ourselves in worship, the summit."

Bishop Cozzens goes on to say, "The Eucharist wants to teach us to make our own lives a gift." It is when we give of ourselves, just as Christ gave of himself on the Cross, that we lead more fully Christian way of life. St. Thomas Aquinas teaches us that love is willing the good of the other as other, not simply because we get something in return or have a mutual interest. Agape love – unconditional love – is what we are called to share. The Eucharist reminds us of this fact! "For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life" (John 3:16). Bishop Cozzens states, "We need to catechize people about this aspect of the Eucharist in order that they might fully live their Christian lives."

How are we doing with this aspect of our catechesis? Is the Eucharist transforming us? Are we giving our total self to Christ (full, active and conscious participation) in the liturgy? These and other questions can help us reflect on how we enter the mysteries of the liturgy and can help us grow closer to Christ when we receive him in the Eucharist.


