

Thank you for the cards and the gifts, I appreciate them all. When I was a kid, my parents taught my siblings and me to be grateful for the gifts that I received; not only because the givers were under no obligation to gift, but also because there were people who did not receive much, if anything at all. Built on top of that during a homily that was given by one of the professors in seminary gave a homily that was focused on gratefulness.
