Thoughts from Fr. Adam...

As we begin the new Year of Our Lord 2025, one of the things I want to do with this bulletin column is to do a bit of a walkthrough of the Mass. It can be helpful for everyone, including myself, in order to grow in our engagement in the Liturgy and help us to grow in faith.

We begin each Mass with one of the first prayers we learn as a Catholic, whether it's as children or as adults: the Sign of the Cross. Tertullian, who lived from 160-240 A.D., "At every forward step and movement, at every going in and out, when we put on our clothes and shoes, when we bathe, when we sit at table, when we light the lamps, on seat, in all the ordinary actions of daily life, we trace upon the forehead the sign." So, even in the early Church, the Sign of the Cross was a part of life. And, it was meant to be intentional, a statement and a request at the same time. A statement that illustrated that in everything that a person did, they are a Christian, and their first priority is to respect and love God. A request that in everything that they do they petition that God will go before them and accompany them.

The Sign of the Cross is also a statement of belief in the Trinity: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It's also a statement of belief in the fact that Jesus died upon the Cross for our sins. And even more so, it's a reminder to us that Jesus calls each and every one of us to take up our cross and follow Him.

We then move to "The Lord be with you" and "and with your spirit". The phrase "The Lord be with you" appears a few times in Scripture, from Ruth 2:4 and 2 Chronicles 15:2. While it is a greeting, it's also a reminder that as we begin the celebration of the Mass, the Lord is with those who are in the congregation, and the response "and with your spirit" is a greeting as well, and is a reminder to the celebrant that the Lord is with him too. The Mass is only able to celebrated because it is the work of the Lord. We are participating in the sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross. The Mass is a divine act of grace in which God's love and power are directly experienced by those participating in Mass.
