

Thoughts from Fr. Adam...

Dear brothers and sisters, on Saturday, May 24th, two men were ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Springfield in Illinois, Fr. Charlie Delano and Fr. Ryan Kehoe. Friday, May 23rd, I celebrated 10 years of being ordained a priest, which we are commemorating on Sunday. Fathers Delano and Kehoe have accepted the calling of Jesus Christ and chose to lay down their lives for the Lord. This is something that myself and my classmates, and priests before me, going back to the presbyters ordained by the Apostles have done as well. This is a daily calling, and sometimes the decision to lay down my life for the Lord is more challenging than others. However, it is always worthwhile. We are reminded of Pope Benedict's words, "Dear friends, God loves us. This is the great truth of our life; it is what makes everything else meaningful." (Homily at the Prayer Vigil with Young People, Madrid, 20 August 2011). I could not have been ordained a priest without the love of God being manifested in my own life. It was something that I couldn't even comprehend, until, as my life has unfolded, God continually drew me in and helped me to understand. And it's something that I am continually called to understand more and more each day. I am not a priest for myself, rather, I am a priest for Jesus Christ and a priest to serve the people of God.

We also mark Memorial Day on Monday, and we respect and honor those who have laid down their lives in service of our country and her citizens. We give thanks for those men and women who have chosen to offer their lives in defense of our freedoms. They have also laid down their lives for the sake of the other. Fr. John Veltri, a Jesuit, composed a prayer for Memorial Day. Part of that prayer is, "O God, you yourself have taught us that no love is greater than that which gives itself for another. These honored dead gave the most precious gift they had, life itself, for loved ones and neighbors, for comrades and country and for us." What do Ordinations and Memorial Day have in common? Well, they are both reminders that we dedicate our lives to what we value. Each and every person gives their life to for the principles and people that they value. As we live our lives, what do our lives demonstrate what we value. Because in everything we do, how we live our life, how we honor God, how we treat others, is the reflection of our belief. What are we willing to lay down our lives for? Would we be willing, are we willing, to dedicate our lives to the glorification of God? Would we be willing, are we willing, to dedicate our lives to sustain our family, our neighbor, our parish? How does our life demonstrate what we believe?

I pray that we all grow in love for God and our neighbor, that we may continue to grow in hope and faith. Let us pray for one another, that we may do as Jesus calls us, "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends." (John 15:13)
