



Thoughts from Fr. Adam...

First and foremost, I would like to give thanks for the receptions that were held and the generosity that everyone has demonstrated, both to me and to our parish communities. I truly appreciate the continuing welcome and opening your lives to me. I pray that I may be as generous and welcoming to you in return. Our generosity to one another helps us to realize that we truly are made in the image and likeness of God. For, when we grow in our understanding that God continually pours out His Grace, Mercy, and Love upon us, we are able to share our generosity with others.

We may, at times, have difficulty with understanding how we are made in the image and likeness of God. God is perfect and all loving and all good, whereas we know our own faults, our sinfulness, and we may repeat after Peter, "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man." (Luke 5:8) It can be difficult to understand how God not only can work through us but wants to work through us. God wants to work through us because He loves us. If He did not love us, He would not have created us in the first place. We hear in 1 John 4:7 "Beloved, let us love one another, because love is of God; everyone who loves is begotten by God and knows God." God loves us and throughout salvation history continues to extend covenants and mercy upon His people. He has given people free will, though, and people continue to choose other things, people, and ideals instead of God. He allows people to face the consequences of their sins though, their choosing something other than Him. And, yet, even as people face the consequences of their sin, of their immorality, God continues to extend His mercy and love to them and calls us back to Himself. Out of His generous love, He gives us His Son, Jesus Christ, to pay the price that we can never pay.

Jesus continues to uphold the 10 Commandments, gives the Beatitudes, calls sinners to repentance and eats with them, and willingly suffers and dies for us. He rises from the grave and ascends to Heaven. 1 John 4 continues in verses 8-11: 8

"Whoever is without love does not know God, for God is love. In this way the love of God was revealed to us: God sent his only Son into the world so that we might have life through him. In this is love: not that we have loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as expiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also must love one another."

We are called to remain in the love of God, to turn away from sin, and to lay down one's life for one another. This doesn't always end in death, although we see throughout history, and even today, that some give their lives for the sake of the faith, for the sake of the other. But when we are generous to one another, when we give of our time and ourselves in order to witness to the love of God, we are reflecting God. That is living out how we are created: in the image and likeness of God.

Know that as I go on retreat this week, I will be praying for you.
