Thoughts from Fr. Adam...

As we start our way into meteorological Summer this weekend, it can be good to examine how we prepare ourselves for Mass. First and foremost, for those who are able to come to Mass, know that we appreciate it. And for those who are unable to, whether due to illness or disability or caretaking responsibilities, know that we hope that someday we hope that you are able to rejoin us. We pray for your health, for the health of loved ones, and that you may know the peace that God gives us all.

For those that are able to attend Mass, it can be a good exercise throughout our lives to pause and ask "Am I ready for Mass?" What motivates you to go to Mass? Is it because "this is what we do as a family", "I'll get in trouble if I don't go", "I want to learn more about the faith", or "This is a gift that I am able to go and participate in Mass"? Well, as a reminder, we all have to start somewhere, and there's no shame in where we start. Hopefully, as we grow in age and as we grow in faith, we can get to the point, of "this is a gift" and "the more I pour into my preparation for Mass the more I will receive and grow." But I don't know that anyone starts at those points. But the more we examine our motivation, the more we are able to develop those spiritual practices. In Plato's Apology, Socrates states, "The unexamined life is not worth living." He says this because he believes that the purpose of life is to grow in wisdom and knowledge. And it's true, we are created for more than just being stagnant.

If we don't examine why we go to Mass, it will be difficult to grow and appreciate what has been given to us. When we understand that Jesus has given Himself to us in the Eucharist, when we understand that the Bible is weaved throughout the Mass, we can continue to grow in our desire to be present at and participate in Mass. Sacrosanctum Concilium, the document on the Liturgy from the Second Vatican Council, states "Mother Church earnestly desires that all the faithful should be led to that fully conscious, and active participation in liturgical celebrations which is demanded by the very nature of the liturgy." So, fully conscious, we should, to the best of our ability, be awake during Mass and aware of what is going on. And not only fully aware, but also we are called to be united to one another during the Mass. Singing, when appropriate, praying the Gloria and the Creed, responding to the priest and praying with the parts of the Mass. All of these liturgical actions deepen our engagement with God, with the Mass, and with one another.

Sometimes growth is hard to perceive; sometimes we seem to invest ourselves wholly into the Mass and afterwards we don't notice anything. But what we invest is not worth it. We can't always see a seed growing, but if we nourish it and cultivate it, it does grow. Brothers and Sisters, God loves us. Do we love Him? How do we live out our love for Him? I pray that each and every one of us may grow in how we prepare ourselves for Mass, not so that others will notice it and compliment us, but so we can more readily express our love for God, inside and outside of the Mass.
