Thoughts from Fr. Adam...

As I write this, I am on the priests retreat up at Sacre Coeur Retreat Center outside Magnolia, Illinois. It is definitely a place that you have to want to get to. It's a retreat center that is run by the Diocese of Peoria, which opened in 2021. It's got nice grounds, good rooms, good food, and two beautiful chapels.

For many years, the priest retreat organized by the Diocese of Springfield has taken place the first full week of June. And, so, it's fitting that we are at Sacre Coeur retreat center, as Sacre Coeur is French for Sacred Heart, and June is the month traditionally devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Now, devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is not a new development, begun in the 20th Century. Instead, this devotion started in the 11th Century. St. Margaret Mary Alacoque had multiple visions of the Sacred Heart between 1673 and 1675, the first Mass in honor of the Sacred Heart was celebrated in Rennes, France on August 31st, 1670, having been composed by St. John Eudes. It was in 1856 that Pope Pius IX made the feast of the Sacred Heart a universal celebration throughout the Church.

Why is devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus important though? Well, as Bishop David Hying writes, "Over the centuries, many Christians developed harsh images of God and Jesus as fearsome judges, distant from human affairs, ready to impose punishment for moral failure."

(https://www.simplycatholic.com/why-the-sacred-heart/). Added to that was the heresy of Jansenism, which developed in the mid-1600's in Western Europe. One of the conclusions of the heresy was that God actively destines some people to receive grace and actively destines others to be without grace. This would mean that God would damn some people to hell because of their sins, when He had not even chosen to give those people His Grace.

This is one of the reasons that we need devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, to understand that Jesus desires to pour out His mercy and His love to all people. We need to understand that Jesus desires all of us to accept His Grace. The Lord Jesus desires that we repent of our sins, to turn towards Him, living in accord with His will. The Lord's will for us is that we have eternal life with Him, the Father, and the Holy Spirit, beginning in this life. The Lord Jesus does not rejoice in our failings, He is not a manipulative, whimsical taskmaster. He desires that we live our life to fulfillment and knows that we will not be fulfilled until we come to life our lives in Him. We read in St. Augustine's Confessions, "For You have formed us for Yourself, and our hearts are restless until they rest in You."

So, it is certainly helpful to cultivate a devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, that we may take refuge in His Heart, resting in His Grace, His Mercy, and His Love.
