Earlier this week, the NBA Draft was held, and earlier this year, the NFL Draft. Now, while I don't play organized sports, and rarely did (the one intramural season I did, I partially tore the ACL in my right knee, so that finished that), I do enjoy watching sports and enjoy the evaluation and draft process. Now, there have been countless people who have tried to compare our Baptism and vocations to God drafting us for "His team." While I find that somewhat cringeworthy, I do understand the motivation to describe it that way. However, if we look at the draft process for professional sports, or even picking teams in school, it's undertaken with the understanding that by picking one person, you are going to, by necessity, exclude others from your team. If we continue to look at the draft process, people are drafted because of what they can contribute to our team, how they can be best used to achieve victory over others.

And, yet, if we look at the Christian life, it's not about how we can best win; Jesus has already been victorious over sin and death. When we enter into life in Christ and remain in Him, we participate in His victory. God has not called us to Himself in order to use us as pieces in a game. Certainly God gives us gifts and planted fruits in us, but that is in order that we may persevere and flourish in our life in Him. But why does He desire that we persevere in the Christian life and flourish? It is because God knows the depths of our hearts and souls and knows that our hearts are restless until they rest in Him. He knows that because He is our creator. The gifts that God gives us we use, not just for perseverance in our own life, but also for the proclamation of the Gospel. And why do we proclaim the Gospel? We do so because understanding God's love for us and modeling our love on His, we love others. We know how to love because we have been loved.

This leads us to the fact that God does not exclude anyone from His love. He desires that each and every person be receptive to His love and grace. Now, this doesn't mean that He forces us to be open to His love and grace, and it also doesn't mean that He forces us to love Him, or one another. God has given us free will so that we may choose to love Him. Love that is coerced is not love at all. Certainly, we can, and some people do, use that choice to not love God; and, so, God never forces us to be united to Him, either in life or after death. Our choices are our own.

As we reflect on the gifts He gives us, including the gift of free will, we can be grateful and rejoice in His love. As we grow in and take refuge in the love of God, we pray that we may grow in love for others. We pray that we may love others, desiring that we may treat others with dignity, and so demonstrate that God not only loves us, but loves them as well. As Dorothy Day said, "I really only love God as much as I love the person I love the least."
